GIRLS

GRADES K-5

JUMPER

- Shift style-emblem optional
- Hemline no more than 2" above/below center of knee, all grades

PANTS

- Solid navy
- Belt is required if pants have loops, solid black, brown or navy in leather or cloth & visible at all times
- No jean or cargo style-no decorative trim
- Elastic waistband accepted

BLOUSE or KNIT POLO

- Solid white with no logo, decorations or designs
- Rounded or pointed collar-long or short sleeve-must be tucked in at all times
- All undershirts must be solid white & tucked in at all times

SWEATER

- Cardigan, pullover or vest without hood or belt/loops
- No longer than 6" below waist
- Solid red, white, gray or navy only

SWEATSHIRT

- Saint Pius X School logo, crew style only - Non-hooded
- Gray or royal blue

FLEECE

- Saint Pius X School logo and the *Spirit Wear fleece, full zip in royal blue only

SOCKS

- Knee, tights, crew length or low cut-must be worn, visible & match
- Solid black, white, gray, red, or navy-no decorations, logos or trim
- No leggings

SHOES

- Dress/casual -solid black, brown, tan, gray or navy
- Athletic – gray, navy, black or white with **one** optional accent color in red, royal, navy, pink, purple, gray , black or white
- No sandals or boots
- Soles in tan, gray, black, white or in the accent color
- Shoes with fluorescent colors or flashing lights are not permitted
- Shoelaces must be corresponding with the main color of the shoe (Laces must be tied)

BOYS

GRADES K-8

PANTS

- Solid navy
- Belt is required if pants have loops & visible at all times
- No jean or cargo style – no decorative trim
- Elastic waistband accepted

BELT

- Solid black, brown or navy in leather or cloth, visible at all times

SHIRT OR KNIT POLO

- Solid light blue with no logo, decorations or designs
- Long or short sleeve-must be tucked in at all times
- All undershirts must be solid white & tucked in at all times

SWEATER

- Cardigan, pullover or vest without hood or belt/loops
- No longer than 6" below waist
- Solid red, white, gray or navy only

SWEATSHIRT

- Saint Pius X School logo, crew style only – Non-hooded
- Gray or royal blue

FLEECE

- Saint Pius X School logo and the *Spirit Wear fleece, full zip in royal blue only

SOCKS

- Crew length or low cut-must be worn, visible & match
- Solid black, white, gray, red, or navy-no decorations, logos or trim (with pants)

SHOES

- Dress/casual -solid black, brown, tan, gray or navy
- Athletic – gray, navy, black or white with **one** optional accent color in red, royal, navy, pink, purple, gray , black or white
- No sandals or boots
- Soles in tan, gray, black, white or in the accent color
